REMOVE NON-FRIABLE ASBESTOS

TRAINING AND ASSESSMENT

OVERVIEW

Master Builders Association of NSW Pty Ltd (Master Builders) is a Registered Training Organisation offering nationally recognised qualifications and courses across New South Wales which meet national industry standards.

The **Remove Non-Friable Asbestos** course is designed to help participants learn how to identify and correctly dispose of asbestos containing materials in a safe way. Participants will gain the necessary skills and knowledge to ensure both their safety and the safety of the people around them when disposing of asbestos containing materials.

The Remove Non-Friable Asbestos course is a legal requirement for workers who may be required to remove more than 10m² of non-friable asbestos(bonded).

The **Remove Non-Friable Asbestos** course is suitable for anyone working in the building, construction, civil construction and demolition sectors who may be required to remove non friable asbestos, either in structures or soils.

PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT

This course has a pre-requisite unit **CPCCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry** that must be completed at least three (3) days prior to the course date. Participants must provide this evidence in one of the following two methods to be able to commence training;

- Successfully complete the online Industry Safety Quiz which is provided by Master Builders following receipt of enrolment Or
- Submit a copy of your Statement of Attainment for unit CPCCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry with your online enrolment

NATIONALLY RECOGNISED TRAINING

Participants who successfully complete this course will be issued a Statement of Attainment for the nationally recognised units of competency:

CPCCDE3014A Remove non-friable asbestos

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no educational entry requirements for this course, however participants must:

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Be proficient in spoken and written English, as the assessments must be undertaken in English
- Bring original identification on the morning of the course according to a value of 100 points as per the Evidence of Identity documentation that will be provided on enrolment
- Be clean shaven on the day of the course

ENROLMENT

On enrolment, you will be required to provide copies of:

- Drivers licence (photo ID with address)
- Green Medicare Card or Passport

Participants will require sufficient language, literacy and numeracy skills to be able to engage in the assessment and to perform workplace tasks such as reading different types of texts, completing written documentation and recording work outcomes. If you require assistance, please contact us to discuss options available to you.

LOCATION AND DURATION

The course is delivered over two days from 8:30am to 4:30pm and can be delivered at various MBA Offices (visit our website for the latest course information).



TRAINING AND ASSESSMENT

The Remove Non-Friable Asbestos unit of competency covers the following topics:

- Plan for asbestos removal
- Prepare asbestos removal area and removal site
- Isolate removal site
- Carry out asbestos removal process
- Carry out decontamination process
- Clean-up work site
- Contribute to and documentation in line with regulatory requirements

This course has been designed to be delivered and assessed face-to-face in a classroom with:

- Written assessments (including a knowledge questionnaire consisting of short answer questions to be completed individually by the participant) to obtain evidence of underpinning knowledge needed to perform asbestos removal activities at a competent level.
- Practical assessment conducted one-on-one, or in a small group. In the case of a small group, the assessor will ensure all aspects of assessment are clearly assessed for each participant in the group (this may involve tasks being completed more than once to ensure each participant is competent).
- Participants will also be assessed on their observable behaviour including oral questions to assess technical criteria relevant to techniques required for this unit of competency.

Participants are provided with a briefing of what is required to successfully complete the assessment. Participants will be made fully aware of the conduct of assessment as well as the required skills, knowledge and behaviour the assessor is looking for within the assessment. Participants are offered multiple opportunities to demonstrate knowledge and skills throughout the program. At the completion of all the assessment tasks the participant will be provided feedback on their abilities and responses.

COURSE MATERIALS

Participants are not required to bring any materials or purchase specific books to complete this course. A pen and notepad for individual note taking is recommended. Master Builders will provide all course materials, resources and access to PPE (if required) on the training day.

CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

Whilst undertaking this course, participants must wear closed footwear and appropriate clothing suitable for a work environment (no thongs, singlets, shorts etc).

UNIQUE STUDENT IDENTIFER (USI)

Any person undertaking nationally recognised training in Australia is required to have a Unique Student Identifier (USI). Master Builders cannot issue a Certificate or Statement of Attainment to a participant who does not have a USI. Master Builders will request the participant creates their USI prior to course commencement.
