

SUPERVISE ASBESTOS REMOVAL

TRAINING AND ASSESSMENT

OVERVIEW

Master Builders Association of NSW Pty Ltd (Master Builders) is a Registered Training Organisation offering nationally recognised qualifications and courses across New South Wales which meet national industry standards.

The Supervise Asbestos Removal course offered is designed to train Participants in instructing and monitoring workers on a jobsite to ensure that they are correctly handling, removing and disposing of asbestos containing materials correctly. In NSW, it is a mandatory requirement to hold CPCBC4051A Supervise asbestos removal if you are a supervisor of Class B (non-friable) asbestos removal.

PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT

This course has a pre-requisite unit **CPCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry** that must be completed at least three (3) days prior to the course date. Participants must provide this evidence in one of the following two methods to be able to commence training;

- Successfully complete the online Industry Safety Quiz which is provided by Master Builders following receipt of enrolment
Or
- Submit a copy of your Statement of Attainment for unit **CPCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry** with your online enrolment

NATIONALLY RECOGNISED TRAINING

Participants who successfully complete this course and are deemed Competent will be issued a Statement of Attainment for the nationally recognised unit of competency:

CPCBC4051A Supervise asbestos removal

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no educational entry requirements for this course, however participants must:

- Hold a statement of attainment for CPCDE3014A Remove non-friable asbestos OR CPCDE3015A Remove friable asbestos
- Be over 18 years of age
- Have a Valid White Card (general construction induction card) issued after September 2009
- Be proficient in spoken and written English, as the assessments must be undertaken in English
- Bring original identification on the morning of the course

ENROLMENT

On enrolment, you will be required to provide copies of:

- Drivers licence (photo ID with address)
- Green Medicare Card or Passport

Participants will require sufficient language, literacy and numeracy skills to be able to engage in the assessment and to perform workplace tasks such as reading different types of texts, completing written documentation and recording work outcomes. If you require assistance, please contact us to discuss options available to you.

LOCATION AND DURATION

The course is delivered over one day from 8:30am to 4:30pm and can be delivered at various MBA Offices (visit our website for the latest course information).



TRAINING AND ASSESSMENT

This unit of competency covers the following topics:

- Plan for asbestos removal
- Prepare site for removal
- Oversee the removal and decontamination process
- Supervise and support team members
- Supervise testing, compliance and documentation in consultation with the licensed asbestos assessor and the licensed asbestos removalist

This course is delivered and assessed face-to-face in a classroom with:

- Written assessments including a knowledge questionnaire consisting of short answer questions to be completed individually by the participant to obtain evidence of underpinning knowledge needed to instruct and monitor workers performing asbestos removal activities at a competent level.
- Practical assessment conducted one-on-one or in a small group. Where a small group is assessed, the assessor will ensure all aspects of assessment are clearly assessed for each participant in the group (this may involve tasks being completed more than once to ensure each participant is competent).
- Participants will also be assessed on their observable behaviour including oral questions to assess technical criteria relevant to techniques required for this unit of competency.

Participants are provided with a briefing of what is required to successfully complete the assessment; to ensure they are completely aware of the conduct of assessment as well as the required skills, knowledge and behaviour the assessor is looking for within the assessment.

Participants are offered multiple opportunities to demonstrate knowledge and skills throughout the program. At the completion of all the assessment tasks the participant will be provided feedback on their abilities and responses.

COURSE MATERIALS

Participants are not required to bring any materials or purchase specific books to complete this course. A pen and notepad for individual note taking is recommended. Master Builders will provide all course materials, resources and access to PPE (including respirators, gloves, disposable overalls, safety glasses, etc) on the training day.

CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

Whilst undertaking this course, participants must wear closed footwear and appropriate clothing suitable for a work environment (no thongs, singlets, shorts etc).

UNIQUE STUDENT IDENTIFIER (USI)

Any person undertaking nationally recognised training in Australia is required to have a Unique Student Identifier (USI). Master Builders cannot issue a Certificate or Statement of Attainment to a participant who does not have a USI. Master Builders will request the participant creates their USI prior to course commencement.
