

SUICIDE PREVENTION GATEKEEPERS TRAINING WORKSHOPS

OVERVIEW

Members are advised that Master Builders NSW (MBA) will be facilitating a series of Suicide Prevention Gatekeepers Training Workshops for MBA members and their employees (including building trade apprentices).

safeTALK (a.k.a. Connector Training) is an evidencebased course delivered in partnership with Mates in Construction.

The Program is funded by the NSW Ministry of Health and delivered for **FREE**.

safeTALK is a half-day face to face course that trains participants to identify people at risk of suicide, engage with them and connect them to resources to help them.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

Participants who enrol in the workshop will have:-

- Understanding of suicide and its impact on industries, communities and individuals;
- Insight into suicide data and how age, gender, culture, and other factors impact suicide risk;
- Understanding of the risk and protective factors and warning signs associated with suicide;
- Skills and confidence to recognise warning signs of suicide in a colleague, friend or family member;
- Understanding of the importance of involving adults when concerned about someone at risk;
- Knowledge of resources and comfort level for connecting others with help;
- Positive attitudes towards helping others; and
- Awareness of the benefits of treatment for mental health and substance abuse issues

Participants who have completed the evidence-based Program will be issued with a completion certificate, safeTALK hard hat sticker and Hi-Vis vest to easily identify them as Suicide Prevention Gatekeepers on building and construction worksites.
